a) Reports from Outside Bodies

EBC At Extraordinary meeting it was unanimously agreed to offer David Brailsford freedom of the Borough.

The fitness gym and the cafe at the West Park Leisure Centre is to be refurbished at a cost of £180,000.

Sandiacre Sports Centre, has some little used space which is to be used by Friesland School for classroom space.

Bonfire and Fireworks will be held this weekend at West Park Leisure.

The Chestnut Fair commences at Long Eaton at 15th November and Diwali Open Workshops on 17th November.

Free Tree Scheme will be held again in Long Eaton on 28th November.

Landowners can apply for up to 50 trees from Jamie Richards, closing date 23rd November.

The Christmas Lights at Ilkeston will be switched on 30th November and at Long Eaton during the first week in December.

Last brown bin collection will be w/c 26th November. Clerk to contact Dave Bramwell regarding the information leaflets regarding collections.

Police Clerk read out the report sent by PCSO Laura Buchanan. There were four incidents recorded since the last meeting and also on 23/10/12 Police speed checks took place on School Lane. Several vehicles were witnessed travelling over the speed limit and letters were sent. Also three HTA's came through the village and letters sent to Companies. Satnav was blamed.

DCC You can now go on line to DCC and see how the budget is set.

Regarding the fire at Stanton Ironworks, the hot ash is to be buried on the site and should be done by today 1st November. It is to be buried in a bed of clay and capped with clay, the work being done by Derbyshire Fire and Rescue who are also investigating the incident.

As mentioned above, Friesland School, Sandiacre - 2 squash courts being refurbished as 4 classrooms and new science block.

Cllr Clare and Cllr Orchard from EBC and Cllr Major from DCC will be meeting on 5th November to consider the Stanton planning application and discuss time scales and briefings for parishes.

138/2012: Minutes – It was RESOLVED to confirm as a correct record the Minutes of the Ordinary Parish Council Meeting held on the 4th October 2012 and these were signed by the Chairman.

141/2012: Update of the Digital Broadband for the area.

Surina updated that not much has been happening with Digital Derbyshire, but Nick Williams at Great Hucklow taken things on himself and has been looking at speeding up the broadband through companies. Surina is to speak to Stanton Bonna to see if they will act on behalf of the village to help obtain 6-7 megabytes. There is a seven and a half million pound grant in DCC which is available dependant on need and for this reason we must encourage parishioners to email DCC to say they have a need. Clerk agreed to prepare a flyer to be distributed to ask parishioners to email Surina via DCC.

142/2012: Update the Council regarding cost and funding for traffic calming measures (David Connell, DCC Environmental Services unable to attend but will update Cllr Major, DCC).

Letter from David Connell was handed out to all Councillors. Cllr Major confirmed that the £5,000.00 from Derbyshire County Council would be agreed. A Public Works loan may be a possibility and clerk to check with DALC. A public consultation will need be carried out.

143/2012: Footpaths.

It was requested that clerk contact David Jenkinson at DCC regarding overgrown footpaths. The footpaths are Footpath 18, Footpath 13 and Footpath 11 between Footpaths 12 and 13.

144/2012: DCC Consultation - Part Street Lighting.

Clerk to reply that lamp 074016 needs to be left on as this is near Middlemore cottages where the road narrows and ambulances may need to access the almshouses. Lamps 074250, 074187 and 074224 could be included in the part lighting.

145/2012: Community Litter Pick.

The Social committee usually organise this event and it is usually poorly attended. Parish Council support was requested and it was agreed to include it in the next newsletter as the date has not yet been decided but will be in the spring. Adults only are able to participate due to safety but Council agreed to support.

146/2012: Confirmation of Extra-Ordinary Meeting to be held on 15th November 2012.

It was agreed a letter to be sent to both Murray Lloyd and Rebekah Paczek to confirm date and venue and express our appreciation that they are attending. Flyers reminding residents are to be delivered.

147/2012: Report of the Parish Clerk on:

- (b) Play area and Village Greens Village. Green was recently redressed and then almost immediately a lorry drove over it.

- (c) Stanton Regeneration – nothing to report. Awaiting reply to letter sent to Jessica Lee MP. Clerk to arrange for a copy to be sent to Cllr Major.
- (d) Dog poop bin – Field Stile/public footpath Dale Road – still no reply. Clerk to chase.

- (e) Allotments: Letter to Tata Steel – Letter sent to ask about the time scale involved in looking at re-instating the allotments. No reply to date.
- (f) Repairs to War Memorials – update. Cllr Homer met Cllr Kevin Miller from War Memorials Trust and he has surveyed the memorial and it is leaning and he will be sending a report of his findings to the War Memorials Trust. Clerk to email Cllr Miller and thank him for his time and help.
- (g) Snow Warden was unable to attend meeting so clerk arranged to post the Fit to Practice form to him and clerk will produce a Risk Assessment and return both the DCC as soon as possible.
- (h) Christmas Lights – Requested to be installed last week of November. Clerk to ask if they can be switched on and checked with a Councillor present before the end of the month to make sure they are evenly spaced and look good.
