

STANTON BY DALE PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Ordinary Parish Council Meeting of the Stanton-by-Dale Parish Council held at 7.30pm, on Thursday 1st October 2015, in the Village Hall, Stanhope Street, Stanton-by-Dale.

155/2015 Apologies – Cllr W Major (DCC); Cllr J Frudd (EBC)

158/2015 Public Speaking – (15 minutes) –

Resident reported pot holes on Hixons Lane, between Moorfield Farm and Lindridge House, vehicles are going on the grass verge to avoid the hole. Clerk to contact DCC. The hole on the pavement reported last month was eventually repaired due to persistence.

Yellow arrows were left in the village by Erewash running club, they had been done with road paint. Long Eaton Running club were responsible and it has been removed with diesel but the tarmac has been effected. To be included on November Agenda to send letter to both clubs.

Agendas are usually on the web site almost a week prior to the meeting, they were late this month. Minutes are on in a different place

Reports from Outside Bodies

Police – Panel Meeting. This is to decide or set priorities for the area. Anti social behaviour at Draycott and speeding vehicles in Stanton-by-Dale have been previous priorities.

Cllr Edinborough confirmed that there are speed watches' arranged in Stanton-by-Dale on 12th October and 12th November. They cannot however take place on the 40mph part of Dale Road as it is not a safe area to do the watch. Heavy lorries are coming through the village in large numbers but it is difficult to see number plates and a lot of residents don't report them. If you see a road traffic incident, also log it and let Cllr Edinborough know. Regarding the incident on Main Street turning from School Lane, mentioned at the last meeting, PCSO Pykett did send information to Dawn Bryant at DCC, who is aware of problems. It was agreed to set the priority to be speeding in Stanton-by-Dale again.

There have been 2 crimes reported since 2nd July to date. They were on 7th July, a non dwelling burglary at Erewash Valley Golf Club and on 16th September at Stanton Bonna, a theft of a pedal cycle.

162/2015 Memorial Bench

Clerk reported that she spoke to DCC and Came and Co (our Insurance Co.) and Came & Co explained that once fitted the Parish Council needed to take it over to cover the inspection and liability insurance ongoing. The Parish Council also needed to complete the application form and send to DCC with the information required and this has been done and the application is now being processed.

It was agreed to put the bench on concrete slabs to help with mowing. This item is to be kept on the agenda for next time.

163/2015 Digital Broadband/Updated website.

Dave reported that Digital Derbyshire say that Box 7 should be done this month and will give faster broadband to part of the village. The rest of the village should be live by March 2016.

Information on a new web site was handed out to the Councillors and some copies of what it would look like. Thanks were expressed to Dave Owens, Glynn Lucas and Cllr Wayne Major for their help pushing for the broadband in the village.

164/2015 Defibrillator/First Aid Instruction.

Cllr Edinborough has spoken to Wayne and Jo at cafe. Wayne is still an active Paramedic so can still do training. It has been left with Wayne at the moment to come back to us. To keep on agenda.

165/2015 Village Hall.

166/2015 Traffic Survey.

It was felt that we need someone from EBC who can give us information on what can and can't be done in the village so that we know what is legal. Suggested contact RoSPA for advice.

Information on how to improve the roads in the village supplied by Mr Howard Foster was looked at and discussed. Clerk to contact DCC.

167/2015 Stanton Regeneration – Butterfly habitat on Stanton Site

Clerk to continue to try and get Steve Birkinshaw or Richard Snow to come and talk to us regarding the site and also regarding the traffic above.

Karen Hodson sent an email regarding the butterfly habitat being destroyed on the Stanton site as large sections of land have been bulldozed to block off and change access to the site. Not sure if there is enough information and what can be achieved. Cllr Harvey to try and get more information for the next meeting.

There is a notice on a lamp post saying major development requiring retrospective planning. No further news on the ongoing development of the site.

168/2015 Ironworks – Noise reported at night.

Resident approached Cllr Edinborough regarding this as they are being woken up by the noise from 11.00pm onwards. There is banging and chains rattling and it goes on until the early hours. Other residents have heard it. At the moment, we are not sure where it is coming from. It is very random and it has been reported to the Environmental Agency. Clerk to write to Steve Hallam at Stanton Bonna and to the Environmental Agency.

169/2015 Town & Parish Councils Minor Maintenance Scheme Consultation Document.

It was RESOLVED not to do consultation.

170/2015 Parish Councils Liaison and Dale Abbey letter.

RESOLVED that Clerk to reply to the letter. The Chair is to send a draft to the Clerk and this is to be circulated by email to be agreed by all Councillors before being sent. Chair said that the way item was recorded was regretted and apologies were given at the word used. Councillors from Dale Abbey requested that the reply to be sent before their next meeting on 15th October.

171/2015 Dale Road Crash site memorial.

Crash involved a Short Stirling Aircraft and the Stirling brothers were born in Stanton by Dale. The crash was on 31st August 1944. Flight Sgnt William Cox was one who died, he had done 32 sorties and been awarded the Distinguished Flying Medal. Clerk to let Cllr Homer have details of the two men who attended the P C meeting a while back and to keep on the agenda.

172/2015 Report of the Parish Clerk on: -
