Police – Inspector Andrews now on maternity leave, the cover in her absence is Inspector Lauren Woods 2483.

Police carried out an operation on weight restriction re the lorries in the village on 3rd December for 4 hours and issued 2 HGV's with tickets for contravening the weight limit and also identified a large number of very large trucks but when they were stopped were below the weight limit. They plan to run another day soon and will keep us informed.

Incidents since last meeting were a theft on Ilkeston Road on 17th November and an attempted theft of a digger on Sowbrook Lane on 24th November with one person arrested and charged.

The amount of £30,000.00 has been allocated to be spent on Erewash Museum and Erewash Borough Councillors approved the replacement of Ilkeston town Centre's radio link equipment. It is hoped that it will be agreed for garden waste to be collected free of charge on demand.
