Reports from Outside Bodies

DCC

There are very few changes to the budget and these will not take place until next year.

Subsidised transport to faith school is to be stopped next year and there is consultation on this. Buses will still run but not be funded.

Next year on 31st August, it will be 70 years since seven crew members died in a crash just outside the village and there is nothing at the site as a memorial. Ted Peck and Dean Wright who attended the meeting to present the item would like to erect something at the site. The aircraft was a Short Stirling LJ630 manufactured by Short Brothers from Lows Lane, Stanton-by-Dale. The site is on Dale Road near Grove Farm. The Parish Council RESOLVED to support the project and help where possible.
