

STANTON BY DALE PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Ordinary Parish Council Meeting of the Stanton-by-Dale Parish Council held at 7.30pm, on Thursday 8th January 2015, in The Old School Hall, School Lane, Stanton-by-Dale.

Reports from Outside Bodies

Police Panel Meeting – Only one reported crime on 19th December in non dwelling premises on Lows Lane when roller shutter doors were jemmied but nothing taken.

The Panel Meeting is to set priorities in the area and the current priority is speeding vehicles on Derby Road at Draycott and regular speed watches are held. Cllr Edinborough asked regarding doing the same in Stanton-by-Dale on School Lane, as on a previous speed watch, 9 warnings were sent out and two vehicles were travelling at almost 60mph. This was agreed with Cllr Edinborough to co-ordinate and PCSO Karen Pykett agreed to arrange the initial meeting to be before the next PC meeting on 5th February at 7pm.

Derby County Cllr Wayne Major agreed to provide £100.00 and Erewash Borough Cllr Val Claire agreed to donate the rest of the cost, ie £30.00 to purchase a new non enforceable speed gun for use in the area.

Cllr Homer asked regarding sales persons at the door asking residents to purchase something to help fund their studies. PCSO Pykett suggested that if residents were worried to telephone 101.

EBC – North community forum on Wed 21 Jan, see details below.

Brown bins have stopped for the winter but if full will be collected by request on the normal recycling day.

One hour free parking in 11 car parks in Ilkeston and Long Eaton instead of 30 minute bays but must collect ticket. This is for a trial period until the end of June to try and boost town centre trade.

Road show for free health checks to be held on 14th January at Ilkeston Library 9.30 to 1.00pm, 15th January at Sure Start, Cotmanhay, 28th January 8.45 – 10.30 at Sandiacre library 9.30 to 1.00pm and on 3rd February at Asda, Long Eaton 10.00 to 2.00pm..

Victoria Park Leisure Centre holding Pilates classes on Mondays and Yoga on Wednesdays.

A petition has been put forward that the roundabout on Nottingham Rd near Morrison's be called Gnome Island.

DCC – Derbyshire County Council have decided to cut annual funding of £150,000.00 to Ozbox and Police say it will have to close. This is disappointing that it started in Derby and is now becoming nation wide. There may be some opposition to the closure.

Cllr Major was aware that gritting of the roads during the snow at end of December did not happen in time before the snow came. Stanton-by-Dale was very bad. Cllr Major mentioning that a private weather monitor costing £40000.00 did not forecast the snow as early as it came and poor decisions were made. The Clerk was asked to contact DCC and ask when Stanton-by-Dale was gritted on 26th December, and to ask for a copy of the report.

 Councillors Phil Woodward and Chris Cotes are going to produce a specification of the work needed to be quoted for at the Village Hall in time for the next meeting and then we can go out for quotes.
 Two quotes were received for 'The Village Hall' sign over the door of the outside door. One for £120.00 for printing on a metal plaque and one for £40.00 for sign writing in paint. It was RESOLVED to accept the painting quote of £40.00 and Cllr Cotes to talk to the painter regarding the font for next meeting.

 It was RESOLVED not to complete the consultation as it was felt we had given our ideas on consultations in the past including important issues which did effect us such as the Core Strategy, Electoral alignment, bus service, mobile libraries and any ideas we have put forward have never been considered. It was RESOLVED to send letter to the Chief Executive with a copy to the Democracy Officer at DCC. Cllr Harvey will draft this and the Clerk will forward to all Councillors for approval.

 - (i) Monthly inspections for September to December were received and no issues. Due to Insurance requiring weekly inspections, Clerk to check with DALC to ask if and when they are having more playground inspection courses and to train at two Councillors to do a weekly inspection. Cllr Edinborough and possibly Cllr Gallagher will do this in the interim
 - b) HGV's being reported now via Cllr M Edinborough. Not many received recently but details have been put onto the Winter Newsletter so hopefully this will remind residents to report them.

 - d) HS2 – It was expected that no decision where the line will go until after the General Election.
